I am happy to note that Artemis Gold's Blackwater Project has proposed open pit gold and silver mining within the Cariboo Regional District Area, which comes under my constituency of Cariboo-Prince George. I write this letter to express my support for this project.

Based on a pre-feasibility study completed in 2020, Artemis expects to invest approximately \$600 million in initial capital in order to commence operations. I am informed that the company expects to hire 825 workers during the construction phases and up to 457 full-time workers during operations. I am delighted to know that the company is committed to hiring local community and Indigenous employees, while a majority of the supplies and contractors will be sourced through local enterprises.

This will no doubt be a boon for our entire region, which is struggling to economically recover in the post COVID-19 world.
